## STANDARD OPERATING OBJECTIVES (the HOW)

- Develop a common work plan that includes items from CHIP & relevant grant objectives
- Increase Coalition membership to include absent sectors (faith based, business, civic, primary care and youth)
- Develop, plan and execute Youth Leadership Forum each school year (Braxton)
- Install Rx drop boxes in practical locations to decrease the availability & abuse of prescription drugs -- Review list of Wayne County Drop boxes in March & September - Ashley (VA) & Dale (CoAFL) & PH updated fall 2023 - listed on Wayne WHIP app and working to get on PH website - partners to help on social media/websites
- Develop and provide Prevention Messaging flyers & graphics to schools to promote awareness
- Increase usage and awareness of a Community Virtual forum - WHIP App
- Increase opportunities for youth to volunteer and engage in community

- Survey existing EBP and research based programs in schools and identify who is providing the programs - Tina M.
- Monitor the implementation of Life Skills Training in grades 6, 7 & 8 (including review of pre- post surveys, instructor feedback and student reaction focus group)
- Organize a professional development forum for school and agency personnel to share experiences with EBP's, needs & rev WHIP ie: RFP data.

- Offer Mental Health First Aid and Youth Mental Health First Aid trainings across the county and introduce t(een)MHFA to school districts
- Offer Trauma Informed Community trainings. Collect and distribute articles for local papers and media around mental health awareness & substance abuse issues. PH to submit something on Wayne Times with Wayne Wellness focus - highlight another agency/program - Red Ribbon week celebrations?
- Develop a list of community awareness presentations for school and community and include youth input. Tina M.
- Survey Schools about PD interests?
