FAQ: What if we can only come one or two days?

Answer: Register now, and then work that out with our team. For two day registration the cost will hold. For single day registrations we can discuss that with you.

FAQ: When do we pay?

Answer: When you know for sure how big your team is. We will start to invoice in April. Register now to hold your space.

FAQ: Can we present or share at the conference.

Answer: Not this year! We are full! But we may need people to help facilitate. If you would like to volunteer, you get a free training session with Ali Hearn on the 16th prior to the start of the conference and you can help us by facilitating small group discussions on the 17th.

May 16th from 4pm- 6pm will be a powerful pre-conference event with Ali Hearn. You will experience the power of connection and learn tools you can take back home and use.

May 17th is an important day to build connections with people from across the state. Regional, state and national leaders will take the stage to share timely updates for the Community Schools movement and open opportunities for all of our voices to be heard on important issues like graduation requirements.

May 18th emphasizes skill development. Trainers like Brian Meyer from Midwest PBIS and Dr. Hayin Kimner join returning experts Abe Fernandez, Dr. Bryant Marks and Ali Hearn to strengthen our skills. You stay with your region and your team. There are no breakout sessions—this is about building skills for your region, county and local teams.

May 19th highlights local and regional examples; you are together in the morning where we will offer examples and ideas and then give you time to digest those examples as a team. For those who can stay the full day- we will have post-lunch breakouts for your team to split up and spend small group time with national pros like Ali Hearn and regional experts like Dr. Lura Lunkenheimer.
