

# The Wayne County Partnership

The Wayne County Partnership met earlier this month. In addition to updates from our workgroups, those gathered also heard the results of the Salvation Army's 2022 Kettle Campaign in Wayne County (details in a future newsletter). Wayne Behavioral spoke about mental health and suicide prevention resources available within the county. Youth Voice was discussed as a concern. How do we (as individuals, as organizations, and as a Partnership) try to listen to the concerns of our young people as we all navigate life in Wayne County? One possible opportunity to hear what our youth are thinking is coming up on April 25, with the return of the Partnership's Youth Leadership Forum. Partnership Co-Chair, Jay Roscup also spoke about the importance of collaboration as we all work toward improving the lives of those we serve -- mostly with extremely limited resources. This was followed by an appeal to complete the Collaboration Assessment Survey to quantify how connected our Partners feel. Roscup pointed out some successes that the Partnership has realized through our deliberate and intentional efforts: in the first year of the Partnership (2012), nearly 50% of graduating high-school seniors reported 5 or more Adverse Childhood Experiences. In 2022, that number has fallen to about 32%. Still too high, but definitely trending in the right direction.

The next Partnership meeting will be shortened to make time for the Rural Mental Health Symposium held on May 10. To register for the meeting, taking place at the Blue Heron Hills Country Club in Macedon, please visit the [Wayne County Connection](#).
